

Supplies for Vera's "Jacob's Cove at Jones Beach" tutorial

Substrate:

9x12" Durabright or Craft Plastic (both by Grafix) cut to 8x10" or whatever size you'd like (8x10" or bigger- Durabright is sold in larger sheets from Blick). You can also use Nara Paper or Yupo, though Yupo might stain a bit if you're lifting any color.

Alcohol inks, all are from Ranger:

- Sailboat
- Aquamarine
- Monsoon
- Latte
- Caramel
- Meadow
- Lettuce
- Espresso
- Teakwood

Brushes:

- 1/4" Deerfoot (I have Princeton Select)
- 1/2" synthetic watercolor brush
- Assorted sizes of round brushes (sizes 3/0-6; I use Princeton Select)
- #1 liner or rigger brush
- 3/4" oval wash brush

Other supplies:

- Reference image- I took a photo at "Jacob's Bay" on the north side of Jones Beach. There are 2 photos- the original and a second I retouched to saturate the colors more
- Well palettes
- Needle tip bottle for reconstituting dried alcohol in palette
- Isopropyl alcohol
- Jars - I use 2, one for cleaning my brushes, and one for clean alcohol
- Makeup cotton swabs (optional)
- Paper towels
- Nitrile gloves
- Scraps of paper to test colors or techniques
