

Colorful Shores

SUPPLY LIST

Substrate/Paper:

- I'll use 5x7" Durabright, but you can use Nara Paper or any back side of photo paper that will lift or wipe back to WHITE of the paper- which is very important for this lesson

I use Ranger alcohol inks, but I encourage you to use what you have.

For the sky:

- - Cloudy Blue (or thin out Sailboat blue with alcohol)
- - Pink Sherbet
- - Shell Pink
- - OR if you don't have any of these colors, use Sailboat blue thinned with alcohol to just make a light blue sky. You can also create any kind of sunset sky to make this your own!!

For the water:

- - Sailboat Blue or Glacier
- - Aquamarine
- - Stream
- - Turquoise
- - Or whatever "blue and turquoise" colors you might have

For the sand:

- - Mushroom
- - OR mix Slate or any gray with a brown color like Espresso or Teakwood OR thin out a black with alcohol and add a brown to it- we want a warm gray color for the sand. You can also use a Copic warm gray if you have it.

Seagulls in the sky:

- - I use Copic Black 100
- - OR use Pitch Black, just let the alcohol evaporate quite a bit so you get a thicker ink
- - OR use a black alcohol ink marker or Sharpie to draw in the seagulls

Other

- An assortment of round and flat synthetic brushes
- A fantastix or cotton swabs
- Clean alcohol in a jar and in a needle tipped bottle
- Alcohol ink a jar for rinsing brushes
